#### 15. To Amersham in Bloom Update, including a brief update on various proposals

The Town Clerk noted the success of this year's bloom campaign culminating in Amersham being named the overall winner of Britain in Bloom 2022. This award is very much attributed to the environmental improvements and the group's engagement within the community.

The committee wished to express their gratitude to the Town Council Office team, Michelle Catanach, Mark Richardson and the depot.

The Town Clerk outlined several proposals for 2023, including:

- The painting of a further ten utility boxes throughout town
- Floral improvements to the verge in Chiltern Ave, to include the planting of small trees with underplating
- The painting of a mural of the wall owned by Mathnasium (Hill Ave)
- Continuing to work and engage with schools
- A potential project to add green roofs to three bus stops in Hill Ave
- The installation of a working clock in the Memorial Gardens to celebrate the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III
- The creation of a children's trail (leaflet)

It was noted that the projects would be funded through sponsorship and monies taken from the Town Centre Improvements (Bloom) budget. The committee **supported** the proposals, on the proviso that the necessary permissions were sought and the implementation of each project cost effective.
