64. <u>APPROVAL OF GRANTS FROM MAYORAL BUDGET:</u>

RESOLVED to approve a grant of £400 for the proposed improvements to the verge/bed at the junction of Springfields and Lexham Gardens. There were two further applications, for which more detailed information has been requested before they can be considered.

65. <u>APPOINTMENT OF CONTRACTOR FOR REPLACEMENT OF HERVINES PARK</u> <u>PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND CONFIRM LOCATION WITHIN THE PARK:</u>

It was noted that analysis of the public consultation showed that 69% of 520 respondents favoured the design by HAGS UK Ltd. The recommendations of the Hervines Park Playground Working Group were also noted. After discussion

RESOLVED to award the contract to HAGS UK Ltd, keeping the new playground in the same location as the original site, with an extension down the field towards Dr Challoner's Grammar School, with a total cost of £150,000. The addition of activity boards and a sign language board will be discussed with the supplier. The Clerk will now seek outside funding towards the project.

66. TRIAL TO REMOVE WASTE BINS FROM HERVINES PARK:

Cllr Barnes reported that the Climate Action Working Group had proposed a trial to remove the bins from Hervines Park in order to encourage visitors to recycle their waste at home. It was noted that where recycling bins are provided in the Council's open spaces, they become contaminated with general waste, so the contents cannot be recycled, leading to recyclable waste going to landfill or incineration. After discussion

RESOLVED to remove the waste bins from Hervines Park for a one month trial, when the new play area is installed in Spring 2025. The matter would be reviewed at the end of the trial period.

67. <u>BARN MEADOW PLAYGROUND – REPLACEMENT OF SEVERAL ITEMS OF</u> <u>PLAY EQUIPMENT:</u>

It was noted that Buckinghamshire Council will not be confirming the value of the contract until February 2025, which is after the Town Council must submit its final precept request. b) Work on Shardeloes roundabout

It was noted that Buckinghamshire Council will be closing the Shardeloes roundabout between 7pm and 7am for 5 days from 26 November, whilst remedial work is undertaken.

72. <u>MATTERS FOR REPORT:</u>

a) Market Hall Project

It was noted that Buckinghamshire Council has stipulated a full road closure of the High Street adjacent to Market Hall while the southern section of the hall is redecorated and the brickwork repointed. With a 3 month waiting time for a road closure application to be processed by Buckinghamshire Council, the project will have to be deferred until April 2025, as the application of lime-mortar to the brickwork cannot be undertaken during the winter months.

It was also reported that there has been no update from the Council's solicitor regarding the proposal from the Amersham Society for the hall to be put into trust status.
