Amersham Town Council manages a wide range of community facilities, from allotments and cemeteries to residential street lighting, community halls, public open spaces, play areas and recreation grounds. We also lead an impressive programme of town-centre enhancements through our Amersham in Bloom initiatives, working closely with our fantastic team of Bloom volunteers.

Alongside maintaining our parks, cemeteries and buildings, our dedicated depot staff carry out devolved services on behalf of Buckinghamshire Council. Their work in Amersham includes cutting grass verges, cleaning road signs, removing graffiti and trimming back foliage along many public footpaths.

For 2026-27, as well as continuing our existing services, we are introducing several new community initiatives. These include establishing a fund to create a new Youth Council, significantly expanding our grant support for local community groups, and hosting additional community events.
