Inside, explore our temporary exhibition "The Town Swarmed with Culture" to find out about how the émigré community of artists, sculptors, photographers and composers made Amersham a vibrant creative hub in the 1940s.

Try your hand at lace-making with our expert volunteers. Sit at the Tudor dinner table, investigate our timeline display from fossils to dolls houses, wander through our medicinal herb garden, treat yourself in our shop.
